IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Waldo Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of chapter 500 of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of 1901 is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 whole of said section and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following:

'Section 6. All the corporation powers of this corporation

- 6 shall be exercised by a board of not less than five directors,
- 7 two-thirds of whom shall be residents of this state, whose
- 8 number and term of office shall be determined by a vote of
- 9 the stockholders at the first meeting held by the incorpo-

10 rators and at each annual meeting thereafter. The affairs II and powers of the corporation may, at the option of the 12 stockholders, be entrusted to an executive board of not less 13 than five members, two-thirds of whom shall be residents 14 of this state, to be, by vote of the stockholders, elected from 15 the full board of directors. The directors of said corpo-16 ration shall be sworn to the proper discharge of their duties, 17 and they shall hold office until others are elected and quali-18 fied in their stead. If a director dies, resigns, or becomes 19 disqualified for any cause, the remaining directors may elect 20 a person to fill the vacancy until the next annual meeting of 21 the corporation. The oath of office of any director shall 22 be taken within thirty days of his election, or his office shall The clerk of such corporation shall, within 23 become vacant. 24 ten days, notify such directors of their election and within 25 thirty days shall publish the list of all persons who have 26 taken the oath of office as directors. The removal of any 27 director from this state shall immediately vacate his office, 28 if such removal leaves less than two-thirds of the member-29 ship resident in the state.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
