RESOLVE, in favor of the Aroostook State Normal

---

School, accompanied by a statement of facts.

*Resolved:* That the sum of ten thousand dollars for the  
2 year 1907 and ten thousand dollars for the year 1908, be and  
3 hereby is appropriated for the completion of the dormitory  
4 of the Aroostook State Normal School, said sum to be  
5 expended under the direction of the board of trustees of  
6 state normal schools.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In 1905 an appropriation of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) was made for the erection in part of a dormitory of the Aroostook State Normal School. It was the intention of the committee recommending this appropriation to have a permanent and, as nearly as possible with reasonable expense, fireproof building. With this object in view they adopted a plan of a building made in the shape of a T constituting three wings with a main entrance. They have erected two of the wings and a large portion of it is fitted up for occupancy. It is now very necessary that the other wing be erected and that the entire building be fitted for occupancy, as there is a demand for greater accommodations for the school at this time.
