STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other waste material into Medomac river, in Liberty, in the county of Waldo, or any of its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Medomac
2 river or any of its tributaries in Liberty in the county of
3 Waldo, any saw-dust, shavings, bark or other mill waste or
4 refuse of any kind, or place or deposit such saw-dust, shav-
5 ings, bark or other mill-waste or refuse of any kind along the
6 banks of said waters in such manner that the same shall
7 fall or be washed into said river or tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more
3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offence.
