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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Street Railway  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the East-  
2 port Street Railway Company which were granted by chapter  
3 four hundred and sixty-five of the Private and Special laws  
4 of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and extended by  
5 chapter one hundred and seventeen of the Private and Special  
6 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and further  
7 extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the Priv-  
8 8 ate and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one,  
9 and further extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-four  
10 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and

11 three, and further extended by chapter one hundred and  
12 thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-  
13 dred and five, are hereby further extended for and during the  
14 period of two years from the seventeenth day of March,  
15 nineteen hundred and seven, and all the rights, powers and  
16 privileges that were granted and acquired by virtue of or  
17 under said acts may and shall be exercised in the same man-  
18 ner and for the same purposes as provided in said chapter  
19 four hundred and sixty-five.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the sixteenth day of  
2 March, nineteen hundred and seven.
