IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the building of piers each side of the
draw in the Rutherford's Island bridge in the town of Bristol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Bristol in the county of Lincoln is
2 hereby authorized to build and maintain piers at the sides
3 of the draw in the Rutherford's Island bridge in said town,
4 extending in either direction. One or more piers, of such
5 size and located in such way as said town may from time to
6 time determine are authorized hereunder, provided the same
7 shall not obstruct said draw.

Sect. 2. The pier already built extending easterly from
2 said bridge is hereby authorized and made legal and valid in
3 all respects as though legislative authority had been given to
4 erect and maintain the same before the building thereof.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
