## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and forty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, relating to the salary of public officers and compensation of members of the government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and six-2 teen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one 3 hundred and forty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred 4 and five, is hereby further amended by adding to the last line 5 of said amended paragraph after the word "dollars" the 6 words 'four hundred dollars extra, annually, for increase in 7 pay of night men,' so that said amended paragraph, as 8 amended, shall read as follows:

'XXVII. Warden of the state prison, eighteen hundred dollars, with the use, without charge, of such part of the II keeper's house and buildings of the state, appurtenant to the prison and yard, as the governor and council may direct, and fuel for his own use; which shall be in full for all services, including the duty of receiving and paying out money for all purposes; deputy warden, one thousand dollars; clerk, one thousand dollars; officer of the guard, six hundred dollars; guards, five hundred dollars each; physician, two hundred and fifty dollars; gate keeper, five hundred dollars; teacher, three hundred dollars; three hundred dollars for commissary in addition to his salary as guard; night watchman, five hundred dollars; four hundred dollars extra, annually, for increase and in pay of night men.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
