## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

---

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and forty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, relating to the salary of public officers and compensation of members of the government.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and forty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, is hereby further amended by adding to the last line of said amended paragraph after the word "dollars" the words 'four hundred dollars extra, annually, for increase in

7 pay of night men,' so that said amended paragraph, as  
8 amended, shall read as follows:

'XXVII. Warden of the state prison, eighteen hundred  
10 dollars, with the use, without charge, of such part of the  
11 keeper's house and buildings of the state, appurtenant to the  
12 prison and yard, as the governor and council may direct, and  
13 fuel for his own use; which shall be in full for all services,  
14 including the duty of receiving and paying out money for  
15 all purposes; deputy warden, one thousand dollars; clerk,  
16 one thousand dollars; officer of the guard, six hundred dol-  
17 lars; guards, five hundred dollars each; physician, two hun-  
18 dred and fifty dollars; chaplain, two hundred and fifty dol-  
19 lars; gate keeper, five hundred dollars; teacher, three hun-  
20 dred dollars; three hundred dollars for commissary in addi-  
21 tion to his salary as guard; night watchman, five hundred  
22 dollars; four hundred dollars extra, annually, for increase  
23 in pay of night men.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
