IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the removal of the bodies of deceased persons from the Hawkes cemetery, so-called, in the town of Windham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Windham is hereby empowered to
2 authorize some suitable person to take up from the old cem-
3 etery in the town of Windham known as Hawkes cemetery
4 the bodies and remains of all deceased persons buried therein
5 and all headstones and markers at the graves therein, and
6 remove said bodies and remains to Knights cemetery,
7 so-called, in said town, and there decently inter the same,
8 and properly reset such headstones and markers over such
9 dead bodies and remains at the expense of said town.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
