IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing towns to maintain private burying grounds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section seventy-one of chapter four of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto at the
3 end of the third line the words 'maintaining private burying
4 grounds established before 1880' so that said section as
5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 71. The voters, at a legal town meeting, may raise
7 the necessary sums for the support of schools and the poor;
8 making and repairing highways, town ways and bridges;
9 purchasing and fencing burying-grounds; maintaining priv-
10 ate burying-grounds established before 1880; purchasing or

11 building and repairing a hearse and hearse house for the
12 exclusive use of its citizens; and for other necessary town
13 charges.'
