IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to make valid the organization of the Wiscasset,
Waterville and Farmington Railway Company and to extend
its charter.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization and incorporation of the Wis-
2 casset, Waterville and Farmington Railway Company is
3 hereby made valid, ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. The deed from the receiver of the Wis-
2 casset, Waterville and Farmington Railroad Company dated
3 January 4, 1907 conveying the railroad, franchise, property

4 and rights of said corporation to the Wiscasset, Waterville
5 and Farmington Railway Company, and all the decrees of
6 court in relation thereto are hereby made valid, ratified and
7 confirmed.

Sect. 3. All the rights, powers and privileges of the Wis-
2 casset, Waterville and Farmington Railroad Company refer-
3 red to in chapter forty-one of the Private and Special Laws
4 of nineteen hundred and three and extended by chapter
5 thirty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-
6 dred and five are hereby further extended for a period of two
7 years from April first nineteen hundred and seven and shall
8 henceforth belong to and may be exercised by said Wiscasset
9 Waterville and Farmington Railway Company.

10 Provided however that all rights of the Wiscasset, Water-
11 ville and Farmington Railway Company as to the location
12 made by the Franklin, Somerset, and Kennebec Railway
13 Company in the towns of Farmington and New Sharon shall
14 cease and determine if within twelve months after April 1st,
15 1907 all final judgments for land damages rendered by the
16 county commissioners court, or supreme judicial court for
17 Franklin county for damages sustained by reason of the
18 location of the Franklin, Somerset and Kennebec Railway
19 Company shall not have been paid, and in case such payments
20 are not paid within the time stated, all rights under said
21 location in said towns shall cease and the rights originally
22 acquired thereby shall revert to the lawful owners of land
23 located on, and all structures on said location in said towns

24 shall pass to the legal owners of said land and wherever any
25 such structure is erected over the highway the municipal
26 officers of the town where the same is erected shall have the
27 right to remove the same after said April 1, 1908.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
