STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide an additional term of the Supreme Judicial
Court for the county of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after April 1st, 1907, there shall be
2 three terms of the supreme judicial court held within and
3 for the county of Oxford instead of two terms as now pro-
4 vided by law.

The additional term shall be held at Rumford Falls in the
6 town of Rumford on the second Tuesday of May annually.

Sect. 2. The county commissioners of Oxford county are
2 hereby authorized and directed to at once make necessary

3 provisions to care for the additional term herein provided
4 also pay to the clerk of courts such sum as is reasonable for
5 extra expense incurred by him by reason of said May term.

Sect. 3. Said May term shall be held without a grand jury
2 unless specially ordered by any judge of said court. All
3 recognizances and other criminal processes made returnable
4 to and to have day in said May term when no criminal busi-
5 ness is transacted shall be continued to and have day in the
6 next term of said court held in said county.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
