AN ACT to incorporate the trustees of Bridgewater Classical
Academy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. A. M. Stackpole, E. C. Fulsome, J. F. Brad-
2 street, A. E. Schriver, Guy C. Fletcher, Harry Hussey and
3 A. M. Stackpole, Jr., their associates and successors are
4 hereby constituted a corporation by the name of the Trustees
5 of Bridgewater Classical Academy. They shall fill all vacan-
6 cies occurring in their numbers, take and hold any estate,
7 personal or real, and shall have all the powers and privileges
8 incident to similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Any three of the persons named in section 1 may

2 call the first meeting of the trustees by notice served upon
3 the others.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved by the
2 governor.
