IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal section 11 of chapter 164 of the Private and Special Laws of 1844, incorporating the Eliot and Kittery Mutual Fire Insurance Company, relating to insurance of property carried by any other company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 11 of chapter 164 of the Private and Special Laws of 1844, which reads as follows: "If insurance on any house or other property shall be and subsist in said company, and in any other office or form and by any other person or persons at the same time, the insurance made in and by this company shall be deemed and become void," is hereby repealed.
