AN ACT to extend the open season for hunting the game bird
known as golden eye or whistler in the county of Hancock.
cock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to hunt, chase, catch and kill
2 the game bird known as golden eye or whistler in the county
3 of Hancock from September first to the first day of February
4 of the following year.

Sect. 2. No person shall, in any one day, kill or have in
2 possession more than fifteen of the above named birds.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the state for the illegal hunting, killing and
4 having in possession of game birds.
