STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Allen brook, so called, and its
tributaries in the town of Exeter, county of Penobscot.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Allen brook, so called, or
3 in any of its tributaries in the town of Exeter, county of
4 Penobscot, for a period of four years from May first, A. D.
5 1907.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the gen-
3 eral law of the state for illegal fishing.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take effect
2 until the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, with-

3 out expense to the state, shall have caused notices to be
4 posted in conspicuous places at or near said pond, setting
5 forth in substance the provisions of this act.
