IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Boyd lake in the county of
Piscataquis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice in
2 Boyd lake in the county of Piscataquis, for pickerel only,
3 from the first day of December of each year to the first day
4 of April of the following year, making four months' open
5 season for ice fishing in this pond instead of two months as
6 now provided by law.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the state for illegal fishing.
