HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to the Springvale Library Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization of the Springvale Library
2 Association organized at Springvale, Sanford, Maine, under
3 the general law July 28 in the year nineteen hundred and
4 six, is hereby made valid and its acts and doings are hereby
5 made legal.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
