
AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Lake Annabessacook, in
the County of Kennebec.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice, as
2 provided in the general law of the State, on Saturday of
3 each week during February and March of each year, in
4 Lake Annabessacook, in the county of Kennebec.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
3 the general law of the State for illegal fishing.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
