### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Ossipee Valley Telegraph and Telephone Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter four hundred and one 2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and 3 eighty-five as amended by section three of chapter one hundred and ninety-five of the Private and Special Laws of 5 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, as amended by section

6 one of chapter two hundred and eighty-four of the Private

7 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, is hereby

8 amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in 9 the place thereof the following:

'Sect. 5. The capital stock of the company shall be one hundred thousand dollars, but the corporation may here after from time to time increase the same by a majority vote of the stockholders whenever it shall be deemed necestary by them for the purposes herein specified; and said corporation may purchase, hold, sell, lease and convey real estate and personal property necessary for the purposes contemplated in this charter, and may issue its bonds in sums of not less than one hundred dollars each, and secure the same by a mortgage of its lines, franchises and property, or in any other manner it may deem proper.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
