IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter 29 of the
Private and Special Laws of 1887, entitled, "An act to incor-
porate the Kennebec Light and Heat Company."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Kennebec Light and Heat Company and its
2 successors and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered
3 to extend its business into and to supply light, heat and
4 power by the manufacture of gas and electricity in and to the
5 town of Manchester and in and to that part of the town of
6 Winthrop which lies southerly and easterly of the following
7 described line: beginning at the point of intersection of the
8 northerly line of the right of way of the Augusta, Winthrop
9 and Gardiner Railway with the boundary line between the

10 said towns of Manchester and Winthrop, and thence run-
11 ning westerly and southerly along the northerly and westerly
12 lines of said right of way to the meridian line sixty-nine (69)
13 degrees and fifty-five (55) minutes west of Greenwich, and
14 thence running southerly by said meridian line to the south
15 boundary line of said town of Winthrop.

And said Kennebec Light and Heat Company, its succes-
17 sors and assigns are hereby given and granted the same
18 authority, rights and privileges to conduct, transact and carry
19 on its business in the said town of Manchester and said
20 part of the town of Winthrop that it has in the other towns
21 named in its act of incorporation and in any acts additional
22 thereto and amendatory thereof.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
