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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred fifteen of the Private  
and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled  
“An Act to incorporate the Madumkeunk Dam and Improve-  
ment Company.”

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section four of chapter three hundred fifteen  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and  
3 three is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 4. Said company may demand and receive a toll  
5 upon all logs and other lumber which may pass over or  
6 through said dams or other improvements, including said

7 booms, to be fixed by said company, but not to exceed fifteen  
8 cents per thousand feet stumpage scale, or, when such logs  
9 or other lumber have not been scaled for stumpage, by either  
10 the scale rendered at the place of destination of such logs  
11 and other lumber, or the boom scale, at the option of said  
12 company, and said company shall have a lien upon such  
13 logs and other lumber until the full amount of toll is paid,  
14 to be enforced by attachment, said lien to continue for  
15 ninety days after such logs and other lumber shall arrive  
16 at their place of destination.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
