HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent the unlawful diversion of water.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whoever unlawfully and intentionally taps or interferes
2 with the water pipes belonging to any city, town or water
3 district or pipes lawfully connected therewith shall be pun-
4 ished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars or by
5 imprisonment for not more than one year or by both such
6 fine and imprisonment.
