IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent the unlawful diversion of water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whoever unlawfully and intentionally taps or interferes

- 2 with the water pipes belonging to any city, town or water
- 3 district or pipes lawfully connected therewith shall be pun-
- 4 ished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars or by
- 5 imprisonment for not more than one year or by both such
- 6 fine and imprisonment.
