HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the Bodwell Water Power Company to

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

generate, use, transmit and sell electricity.

Section 1. Section one of chapter eighty-one of the Pri-
2 vate and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three,
3 approved February twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and
4 three, entitled "An Act to authorize the Bodwell Water
5 Power Company to generate, use, transmit and sell elec-
6 tricity," is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

'Section 1. The Bodwell Water Power Company is here-
8 by specially authorized and empowered to make and gen-

9 erate electricity upon its property situated on the Penobscot
10 river between the towns of Old Town and Milford and also
11 on the dam or dams which it proposes to erect on the Still-
12 water branch of the Penobscot river at Gilman Falls, so
13 called, in connection with dams erected and to be erected
14 on the Penobscot river, and to use said electricity as a
15 motive power in the use and development of its property,
16 and also to sell the same for mechanical, manufacturing and
17 heating purposes, and to sell the same for lighting purposes
18 to any company authorized to do a general lighting busi-
19 ness, or that may hereafter be authorized to do a general
20 lighting business, and where power is sold to persons, firms
21 or corporations for mechanical or manufacturing purposes
22 to sell the same to said persons, firms or corporations in
23 connection therewith for lighting the premises owned or
24 occupied by said persons, firms or corporations, and to sell
25 the same to persons or firms desiring to do an electrical
26 lighting business in the towns of Bradley and Hampden in
27 Penobscot county, and to sell the same for motive power
28 in the operation of any and all electric railways, and also
29 to carry and conduct electricity made and generated upon
30 its property between the towns of Old Town and Milford
31 to and into any towns or cities in the county of Penobscot,
32 State of Maine, and there to use the same in all ways for
33 its own purposes and there to sell the same for mechanical,
34 manufacturing, heating and said lighting purposes. But
35 nothing herein contained shall be held to authorize said

36 Bodwell Water Power Company to do a general lighting
37 business. And said company is also authorized and em-
38 powered to sell and supply electricity to any street railroad
39 company now existing or hereafter to be created.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
