STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, entitled "An Act to amend section one of chapter eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled 'An Act to authorize the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to make, generate, use, transmit and sell electricity.'"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred forty-three
2 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
3 five, entitled, "An Act to amend section one of chapter

4 eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
5 hundred and three, entitled, 'An Act to authorize the Penob-
6 scot Chemical Fibre Company to make, generate, use, trans-
7 mit and sell electricity,' " is hereby amended so as to read
8 as follows :

'Sect. 1. The Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company is
10 hereby specially authorized and empowered to make and
11 generate electricity upon its property situated upon the
12 Penobscot river between the towns of Oldtown and Bradley,
13 and also on any dam or dams which it has or may erect on
14 its property situated on said Penobscot river as aforesaid
15 and to use said electricity as a motive power in the use and
16 development of its property, and also to sell the same for
17 mechanical, manufacturing and heating purposes, and to sell
18 the same for lighting purposes to any company authorized
19 to do a general lighting business, or that may hereafter be
20 authorized to do a general lighting business, and where
21 power is sold to persons, firms or corporations for mechani-
22 cal or manufacturing purposes to sell the same to said per-
23 sons, firms or corporations in connection therewith for light-
24 ing the premises owned or occupied by said persons, firms
25 or corporations, and to sell the same to persons or firms
26 desiring to do an electrical lighting business in the towns of
27 Bradley and Hampden in Penobscot county, and to sell the
28 same for motor power in the operation of any and all elec-
29 tric and steam railways, and also to carry and conduct elec-
30 tricity made and generated upon its property between the

31 towns of Oldtown and Bradley to and into any towns or
32 cities in the county of Penobscot, state of Maine, and there
33 to use the same in all ways for its own purposes, and there
34 to sell the same for mechanical, manufacturing, heating and
35 said lighting purposes. But nothing herein contained shall
36 be held to authorize said Penobscot Chemical Fibre Com-
37 pany to do a general lighting business. And said company
38 is also authorized and empowered to sell and supply elec-
39 tricity to any street railway company now existing or here-
40 after to be created.

And said company is also further authorized and empow-
42 ered to carry and conduct electricity made and generated
43 upon its property between the towns of Oldtown and Brad-
44 ley as aforesaid, to and into any towns or cities in the county
45 of Waldo except the city of Belfast and to use the same in
46 all ways for its own purposes and there to sell the same for
47 manufacturing and heating purposes, but not for electric
48 lighting or street railway purposes in the county of Waldo
49 except to the Searsport Electric Light Company or its suc-
50 cessors. But nothing herein contained shall prevent any
51 corporation which may hereafter be organized under the
52 general law from generating, selling, distributing or sup-
53 plying electricity in any of the towns or cities in the county
54 of Waldo.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
