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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to authorize the construction and maintenance of a wharf into the tide waters of Casco Bay on Orr's Island in the town of Harpswell, Maine.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Bradbury G. Wilson of Harpswell, Maine, and his assigns, are hereby authorized to construct and maintain a wharf from the land of said Wilson on the westerly side of said island into the tide waters of Casco bay.

Sect. 2. The location and erection of any wharf already constructed into the tide waters of Basco bay from the land of said Wilson, on the shore of said Orr's Island, is hereby legalized, ratified and confirmed, and the said Bradbury G. Wilson and his assigns are hereby authorized to maintain said structure as a wharf.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
