IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter four of the Revised Statutes, relating to election of Road Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter four of the Revised Statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "election"
- 3 in the third line of said section the words 'or for the term
- 4 of three years from the date of his election if the town shall
- 5 so vote,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-

6 lows:

'Sect. 13. Each town at its annual meeting may elect by 8 major vote a road commissioner, who shall hold his office

9 for the term of one year from the date of his election or for to the term of three years from the date of his election if the 11 town shall so vote. Any town may, at its option, elect not 12 more than three commissioners, whose powers and duties 13 shall be the same as prescribed for a single commissioner. 14 No person shall at the same time, hold the office of road 15 commissioner and selectman.'
