STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of building a bridge in the town of Forest City.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be and hereby is appropriated to assist in the construction of a bridge in the town of Forest City in Washington county, the same to be expended by an agent to be appointed by the county commissioners of Washington county, said amount to be paid upon the certificate of said agent that said bridge has been constructed at an expense of not less than three hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is to assist in building a bridge thirty-five feet long over a canal eighteen feet deep in the town of Forest City. Forest City is a poor town having only thirty taxpayers and has five miles of road and three bridges to keep in repair.
