### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE in favor of the town of Trescott.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated; two hundred and fifty dollars for 3 the year nineteen hundred and seven and two hundred 4 and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight, 5 to the town of Trescott in maintaining its roads and 6 bridges, said sums to be expended under the direction of 7 the county commissioners of Washington county.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Town of Trsecott has a valuation of fifty-nine thousand dollars, which is a full valuation of all property in the town. The rate of taxation is thirty-seven mills on the dollar, an increase of two mills over last year. They also have a town debt of twenty-five hundred dollars; there are thirty-eight miles of county road; they have five bridges, which including approaches, are from fifty to sixty feet long. Eleven bridges from eight to fifteen feet long. There is only one small industry in the town, viz., one small box mill.
