STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Howland for purpose of
repairing bridge across Seboice River.

Resolve, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the town of
3 Howland, to be expended under the direction of the road
4 commissioner of said town for the purpose of repairing
5 bridge across the Seboice river in said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge of seventy-five feet which crosses Seboice stream in Howland is on one of the county roads leading from the towns in the Piscataquis and the northern part of the Kennebec county, and there is a vast amount of travel over this bridge; and it will have to be planked and painted during this coming year, which will cost three hundred dollars.
