## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend and extend the Milbridge and Cherryfield Street Railway Charter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. That the rights, powers and privileges of the
- 2 Milbridge and Cherryfield Street Railway Co., which were
- 3 granted by chapter three hundred two of the private and
- 4 special laws of the year nineteen hundred and five are hereby
- 5 extended for a period of two years from and after the
- 6 approval of this act.
- Sect. 2. That chapter three hundred and two of the private
- 2 and special laws of the year nineteen hundred and five, is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out the words "E. K. Wilson"

4 in the first line and inserting in place thereof the words 5 'Charles Stewart,' so that said section shall read as follows: 'Sect. 1. Charles Stewart, William M. Nash, Samuel M. 7 Campbell of Cherryfield, Charles E. Goodwin, Frederick 8 Yates, Edgar A. Hubbard, severally of Biddeford, James 9 O. Bradbury of Saco, and Jasper Wyman and George A. 10 Sawyer of Milbridge, are hereby made a corporation under 11 the name of Milbridge and Cherryfield Street Railway 12 Company with authority to construct, operate and maintain 13 a street railroad for street traffic for the conveyance of per-14 sons and property, in the towns of Milbridge and Cherry-15 field, along and over such streets, roads and ways therein 16 as shall, from time to time, be deemed best for the public 17 convenience by the said company, and over and across such 18 lands as may seem to it advisable and necessary, with such 10 single or double tracks, side tracks, switches, turnouts, sta-20 tions and appurtenances and with such poles, wires and 21 appurtenances as shall be reasonably convenient in the prem-22 ises, with all the powers and privileges incident to or usu-23 ally granted to similar corporations.

This act shall take effect when approved.
