

RESOLVE to rebuild the State Bridge across Depot Stream in Township Number Thirteen, Range Fifteen in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That there be appropriated out of any money in 2 the treasury, the sum of five hundred dollars to assist in 3 rebuilding the bridge over Depot stream on the road leading 4 from Seven Islands on the upper St. John river to St. Pam-5 phile, in the province of Quebec, Canada. Said bridge being 6 situated in the township Number Thirteen, Range Fifteen, 7 W. E. L. S., in the county of Aroostook. Said money to be 8 expended under the supervision of the state commissioner of 9 highways, and said money shall be paid upon vouchers satis-10 factory to the governor and council.
