## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Sebasticook and Moosehead Railroad Company to extend its line to Elliottsville Plantation and to Albion.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The Sebasticook and Moosehead Railroad

- 2 Company, a corporation existing by law in the state of
- 3 Maine, is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its
- 4 line of railroad from Mainstream in the town of Harmony,
- 5 Maine, by a feasible route to some convenient point near
- 6 Qanwa Lake to a junction with the Canadian Pacific man-
- 7 road, passing through the town of Harmony, Cambridge,
- 8 Wellington, Parkman, Kingsbury, Abbot, Guilford, Willi-

9 mantic and Elliottsville Plantation, and to extend its line of railroad from Pittsfield in the county of Somerset by some 11 feasible route to a junction with the Wiscasset and Quebec 12 Railroad in the town of Albion, passing through the towns 13 of Pittsfield, Burnham, Albion and Unity Plantation, or any 14 either, or all of the aboved named towns and plantations, 15 and all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities which 16 were given to said corporation for the extension of its line 17 of railroad from Hartland to Athens by chapter one hundred 18 seventy one of the private and special laws of the state of 19 Maine for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, shall 20 apply to the extension authorized by this act, including the 21 right to erect and maintain telegraph and telephone lines 22 along said railroad.

Sect. 2. The capital stock of said corporation, may, by 2 vote of its stockholders, be increased, from time to time, to 3 not exceeding twenty thousand shares of the par value of 4 fifty dollars each, and may issue its scrip, bonds, or other 5 negotiable promises to aid the purposes of its corporation, 6 and may secure same or any part thereof by mortgage of 7 its property and franchises. The work of construction on 8 the extension lines authorized by this act shall not begin 9 later than May 30th in the year of our Lord one thousand 10 nine hundred and nine.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
