RESOLVE in aid of navigation on Schoodic Grand Lake.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby
2 appropriated for placing and maintaining buoys, and in aid
3 of navigation, in Schoodic Grand Lake in Aroostook county.
4 All of said money to be expended under the direction of
5 the state steamboat inspectors.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Schoodic Grand Lake ranks high in size and importance among the largest lakes in the state. It is navigated by many boats and as a protection to life and property a system of buoys should be maintained.
