STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in aid of repairs of road leading from Northwest
Carry on Moosehead Lake to the Pittston Farm on the West
Branch of the Penobscot River.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in the repair of
3 the road leading from the Northwest Carry on Moosehead
4 Lake to the Pittston Farm at the confluence of the north
5 and south branches of the West Branch of the Penobscot
6 River. The same to be expended under the direction of an
7 agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor and
8 council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road has been a thoroughfare for the lumber operators for more than half a century and over it must of necessity be transported great quantities of freight and supplies for numerous lumber camps. It is also used by a large and constantly increasing number of sportsmen and tourists in the summer and fall of the year. The road is in great need of repairs. During the season when the ground is bare transportation over it is exceedingly difficult.
