HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to coroners' inquests in case of fatal acci-  
dents on railroads.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The provisions of section 69 of chapter 52 of  
2 the Revised Statutes shall apply to all coroner's inquests held  
3 in cases where any person shall be fatally injured on any  
4 steam railroad or street railroad in this state, and the coroner  
5 in such cases shall have all the powers of the board of rail-  
6 road commissioners as specified in said section 69.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
