AN ACT to authorize the Atlantic Shore Line Railway to dis-
continue operation of its ferry across the Piscataqua River in
certain instances.

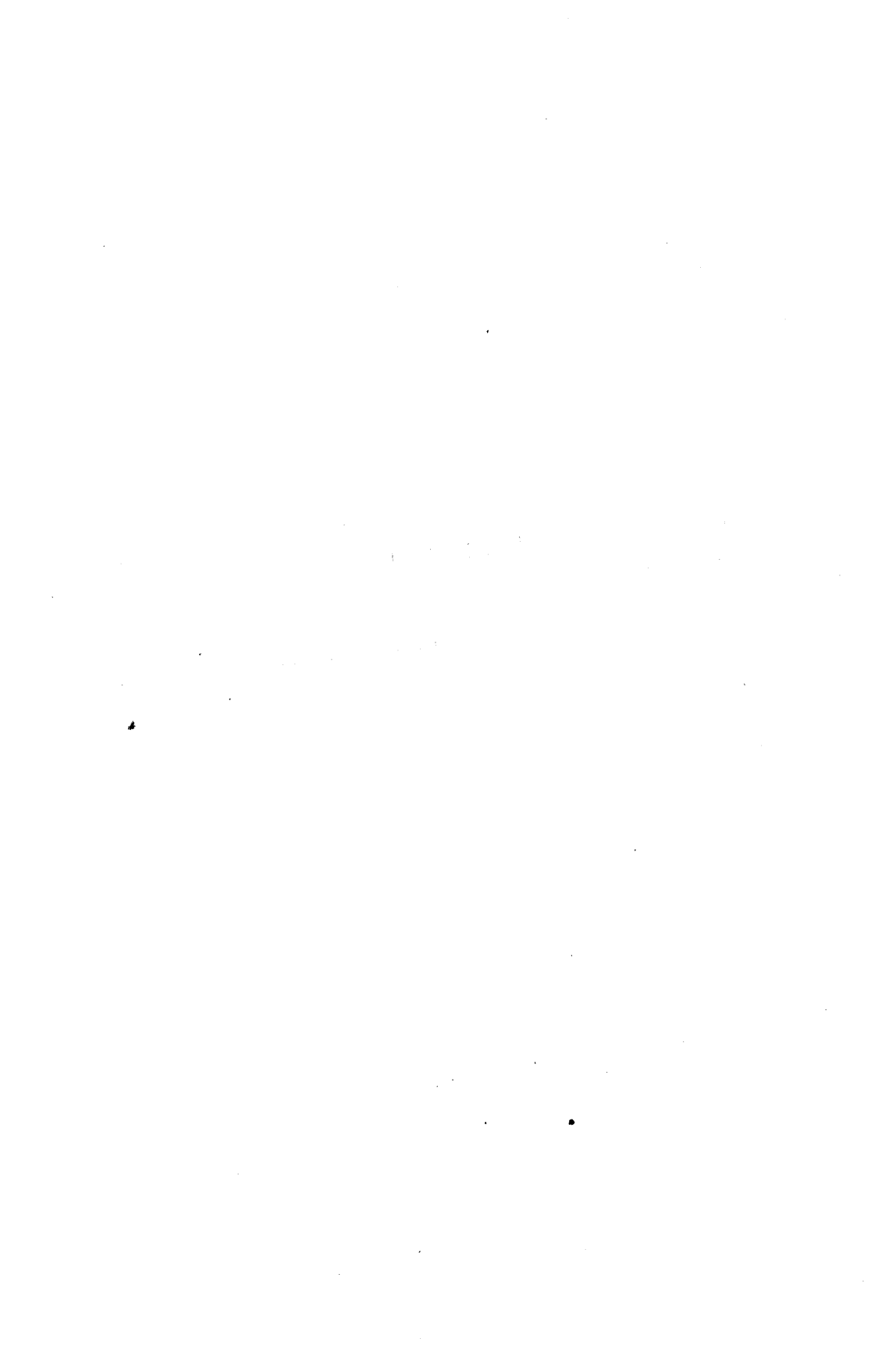
*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Atlantic Shore Line Railway is hereby
2 authorized to discontinue the carriage of animals, vehicles
3 and animals attached to vehicles upon its ferry across the
4 Piscataqua river during such period or periods and at such
5 time or times as it may elect not to engage in such carriage.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may close its bridge extending
2 from the main land to Kittery Foreside to Badger's Island
3 to travel by animals and vehicles and vehicles drawn by

4 animals at such time or times and for such period or periods
5 as it may elect.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
