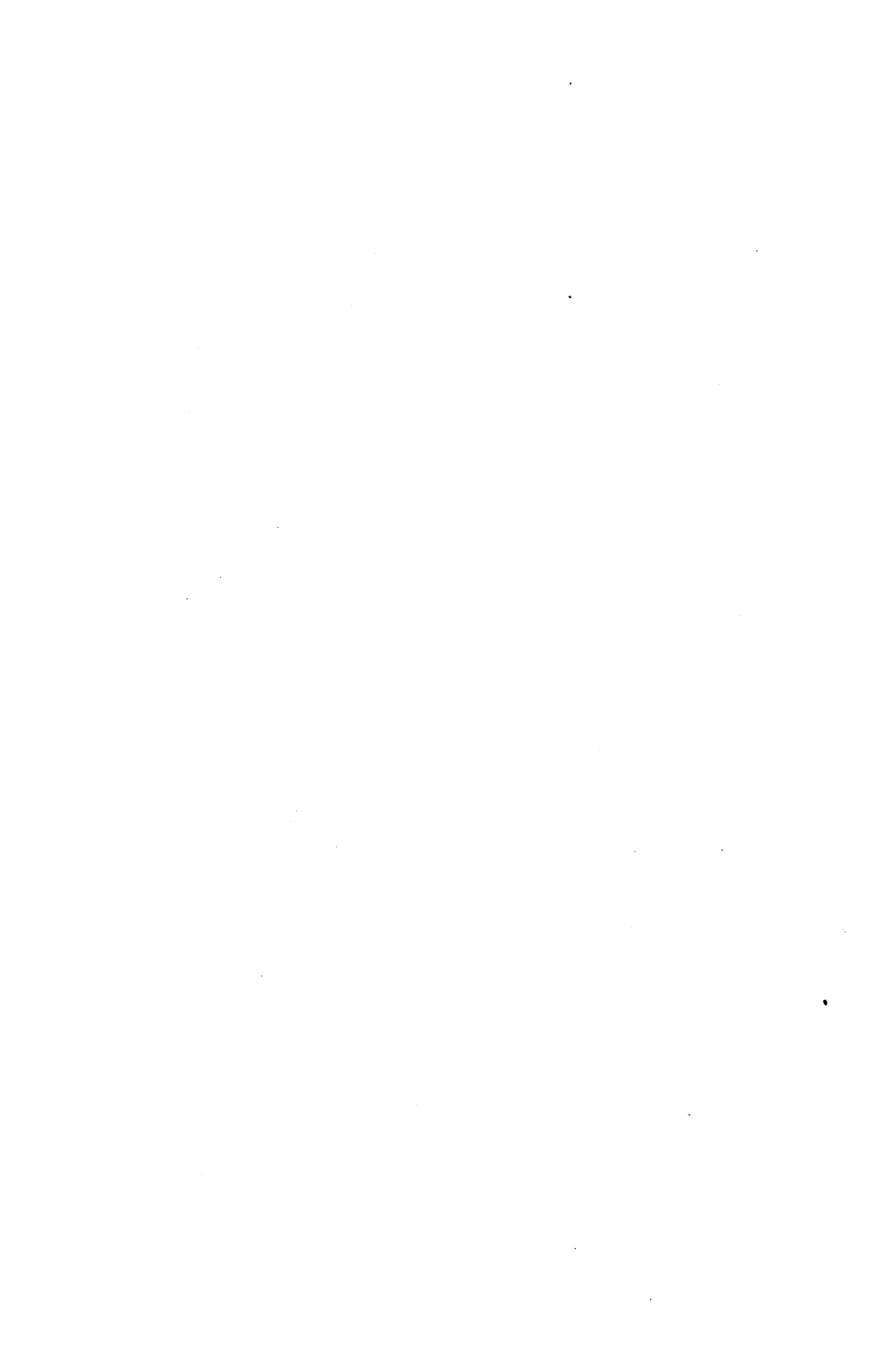

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Seaman Louis D. Greenwood of the 1st division of Naval Reserves of the National Guard of the State of Maine was injured in the line of duty in camp at High Head, Harpswell, July 1904. On account of these injuries Mr. Greenwood was unable to work for several weeks and as he was obliged to lose his time he feels that the state should settle his physician's bill.
