STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Oldtown Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Old-2 town Trust Company, which were granted by chapter two 3 hundred and forty-seven of the private and special laws of 4 nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for two 5 years from the approval of this act; and the persons named 6 in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the 7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by 8 said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the 9 same purpose as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
