STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section I of chapter 381 of the Revised Statutes relating to the taking of eels in the Damariscotta River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Section I of chapter 39I of the Revised Stat-2 utes is hereby amended by adding to said section the follow-3 ing:

'except that eels may be caught by potting, trapping, netting 5 or any other devise, in the waters and tributaries of the 6 Damariscotta river during the months of September and 7 October, to the south of a line drawn from the east shore 8 said river in the town of Bristol at the north side of the 9 northern ice house at Clarks Cove, so-called, west to a

IC point opposite on the west shore of said river in the town II of Edgcomb.'

Sect. 2. Section 2 of chapter 391 of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby amended by adding to said section the following:
 'except during the months of September and October in
4 the territories excepted in section 1,' so that the law as
5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. It shall not be lawful for any person to catch or 7 take eels from Damariscotta river or pond during the months 8 of May, June, July, August, September and October, by 9 potting, trapping, netting, or by any other devise; and any 10 person so offending shall, on conviction, forfeit and pay a II fine of not less than five, nor more than twenty dollars, to 12 be recovered in an action of debt, one-half to the complain-13 ant, and the other half to the town where the offense is com-14 mitted, before any trial justice in the county of Lincoln; 15 except that eels may be caught by potting, trapping, netting 16 or any other devise, in the waters and tributaries of the 17 Damariscotta river during the months of September and 18 October, to the south of a line drawn from the east shore 10 of said river in the town of Bristol at the north side of the 20 northern ice house at Clarks Cove, so called, west to a point 21 opposite on the west shore of said river in the town of Edge-22 comb.

Sect. 2. It shall be lawful for any person finding any pots, 2 traps, nets or other devices set in said waters for the pur-3 pose of catching or taking eels during said months, to

- 4 remove and destroy the same except during the months of .
