STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in the tributaries of Mount Blue
pond, in Avon, in the County of Franklin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries of
3 Mt. Blue pond, which pond is situated in the town of Avon,
4 in the county of Franklin, for a period of four years from
5 the date of the passage of this act.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars
3 nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and
4 a further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken in viola-
5 tion of the provisions hereof.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take effect
2 until the commissioners of inland fisheries and game shall
3 have caused notices to this effect to be posted, without
4 expense to the state, along the banks of the waters to be
5 affected by this law.
