IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINË HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Pocasset lake and Pickerel pond, in the town of Wayne, in the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

2 kill any kind of fish through the ice in Pocasset lake or in 3 Pickerel pond, in the town of Wayne, county of Kennebec.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this

2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the

3 general law of the state for illegal fishing.
