## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other refuse into Olamon stream, so called, in the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Olamon
- 2 stream, so called, in the county of Penobscot, any sawdust,
- 3 shavings, bark or other mill waste or refuse of any kind,
- 4 or place or deposit such sawdust, shavings, bark or other
- 5 mill waste or refuse of any kind along the banks of said
- 6 waters in such manner that the same shall fall or be washed
- 7 into said stream.
- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
- 2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five nor more
- 3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offense.
