IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

---

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other refuse  
into Olamon stream, so called, in the County of Penobscot.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Olamon  
2 stream, so called, in the county of Penobscot, any sawdust,  
3 shavings, bark or other mill waste or refuse of any kind,  
4 or place or deposit such sawdust, shavings, bark or other  
5 mill waste or refuse of any kind along the banks of said  
6 waters in such manner that the same shall fall or be washed  
7 into said stream.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five nor more  
3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offense.
