RESOLVE in favor of A. F. Arbo of T. 5, R. 9, county of
Piscataquis.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty dollars be and is hereby
2 appropriated to be paid to A. F. Arbo of T. 5, R. 9, Piscata-
3 quis county, to reimburse him for sheep killed by bears.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is asked for in view of the fact that the statutes do not provide for the payment of damage or loss of sheep in unorganized places.

Mr. Arbo had four sheep, valued at \$5 each, killed by bears in 1905, and in view of the present law has been unable to obtain redress for the same.
