## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of trout in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or 2 kill any trout in any of the waters lying wholly or partly 3 in the county of Washington for sale, and it shall likewise 4 be unlawful to sell or offer for sale, directly or indirectly, 5 any trout in said Washington county, and it shall likewise 6 be unlawful to take, catch, kill or have in possession in any 7 one day more than twenty-five pounds of black bass from 8 any of the waters lying wholly or partly in the county of

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of 2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten

9 Washington.

- 3 dollars and costs nor more than thirty dollars and costs for
- 4 each offense and one dollar additional for every fish caught,
- 5 had in possession or sold in violation of the provisions of  $\cdot$
