IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of trout in Washington County.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kil. any trout in any of the waters lying wholly or partly  
3 in the county of Washington for sale, and it shall likewise  
4 be unlawful to sell or offer for sale, directly or indirectly,  
5 any trout in said Washington county, and it shall likewise  
6 be unlawful to take, catch, kill or have in possession in any  
7 one day more than twenty-five pounds of black bass from  
8 any of the waters lying wholly or partly in the county of  
9 Washington.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of  
2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten

3 dollars and costs nor more than thirty dollars and costs for  
4 each offense and one dollar additional for every fish caught,  
5 had in possession or sold in violation of the provisions of  
6 this act.
