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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-seven of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to Paupers.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All bills for support of state paupers shall be  
2 filed with the governor and council within three months after  
3 the same are contracted, and no such bills shall be allowed  
4 unless they are so filed within thirty days after the thirty-  
5 first day of December of the year in which they are con-  
6 tracted.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
