STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one, chapter one hundred and twenty-nine of the Revised Statutes relating to Pollution of Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-nine of the 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out from the 3 fourth and fifth lines thereof the words "the water supply of 4 any water company or of any city or town supplying its 5 inhabitants with water" and inserting instead thereof the 6 words 'any public water supply' so that said section as 7 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. Whoever knowingly and wilfully poisons, defiles 9 or in any way corrupts the waters of any well, spring, brook,

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10 lake, pond, river or reservoir, used for domestic purposes 11 for man or beast, or knowingly corrupts the sources of any 12 public water supply, or the tributaries of said sources of sup-13 ply in such manner as to affect the purity of the water so 14 supplied, or knowingly defiles such water in any manner, 15 whether the same be frozen or not, or puts the carcass of 16 any dead animal or other offensive material into said waters, 17 or upon the ice thereof, shall be punished by a fine not 18 exceeding one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment not 19 exceeding one year.' 1 ÿ House of Representatives, Augusta, March 13, 1907.
