STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of building a breakwater in Moosehead
Lake near Kineo.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars
2 be, and is hereby appropriated to build or help build a
3 breakwater in Moosehead Lake, to extend between the light
4 pier southerly of Kineo wharf and shore of Moosehead
5 Lake at Kineo Point, and that the county commissioners of
6 Piscataquis county are hereby authorized to locate said
7 breakwater between said points, that said money be ex-
8 pended under their direction with the advice of the gov-
9 ernor and council; provided, however, that the total cost of
10 the breakwater shall not be less than three thousand
11 (\$3,000) dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The various transportation companies running steamboats on Moosehead Lake annually land many thousand passengers at Kineo wharf on the shore of said lake. The situation of this wharf is such that during the severe southerly winds which often prevail on that lake during the summer season the wharf is not a safe landing place for steamers. The only way to make it thoroughly safe is to build a breakwater at an estimated cost of not less than three thousand dollars.
